

Education Committee Policy

The Education Committee shall be a standing committee of Myrtle Lodge #145.

Purpose

1. Provide direction and guidance in the short and long term educational goals of Myrtle Lodge #145.

Membership

1. The Worshipful Master will appoint the membership of the committee annually.
2. Membership shall be selected from the Lodge, will consist of an odd number of members, and number no less than three with the exact number to be decided annually by the Worshipful Master.

Duties

1. Evaluate program value and educational opportunities while seeking new and innovative methods to meet the growing and changing educational needs of the Brethren.
2. Develop or procure educational programs, presentations, or material which has value either of a Masonic, moral, informative, historical, developmental, or educational nature.
3. Maintain the Lodge Library
 - a. Insure that material included in the Library is of a Masonic or appropriate educational nature.
 - b. Insure all books, periodicals, and materials of the Library are properly catalogued and stored.
 - c. Establish and maintain checkout procedures for Library material.
