Procedure to obtain an exception to Lodge policy

Should a member desire an exception be granted to him regarding a specific policy, and provided that the specified policy does not contain provisions for how an exception can be obtained uniquely for said policy, then the member may petition for exception to policy utilizing the following procedure:

- 1) Member will petition the Worshipful Master for exception.
- 2) The Worshipful Master will appoint a committee consisting of not less than three members whose charge will be to investigate the petitioning members request and determine the need for said exception.
- 3) The committee will report its findings to the membership during a Stated Meeting.
- 4) Should the membership desire to call for a vote for approval of the exception, then a simple majority will be required for the approval of the exception.
